- 2. There is undercover parking for residents' vehicles included in the prices. One vehicle per cottage. Second vehicle parking is charged at R106 per month (space permitting)
- 3. The estate is securely fenced with electric fencing and the gate is manned al all times (24 hours a day)
- 4. All residents have access to the daily clinic for minor medical checks (eg. blood pressure and blood sugars) as well as the treatment of minor injuries.
